WHEREAS, the Retirement Commission of the Wayne County Employees' Retirement System (the "Retirement Commission") is vested with the fiduciary responsibility for the proper administration, management and operation of the Retirement System, and for making effective the Retirement System provisions, and

WHEREAS, the Retirement Commission notes the provisions of Section 141-35(f)(5) of the Retirement Ordinance and Section 13(5) of Public Act 314 of 1965, as amended [MCL 38.1133(5)], authorize the Retirement Commission to use a portion of the Retirement System's

income to defray the costs of investing, managing, and protecting the assets of the system, as well as retaining the services necessary for the conduct of the affairs of the system, including investment advisors and consultants, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to its Service Provider Review Policy, the Retirement Commission periodically reviews the performance, cost, and services offered by its Professional Service Providers; and

WHEREAS, the Retirement Commission conducts due diligence on its Professional Service Providers by analyzing and comparing both existing and prospective Professional Service Providers by methods including, but not limited to, comparing formal proposals; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to its Service Provider Review Policy, the Retirement Commission desired to conduct due diligence on its Investment Consultant and issue a Request for Proposals ("RFP") for the Defined Benefit Plan Investment Consultant; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the review process outlined in Section 10(c) of the Retirement Commission's Rule of Procedure, the Executive Director, with assistance from the Retirement Commission's legal counsel, drafted an RFP for the Defined Benefit Plan Investment Consultant, and

WHEREAS, at its December 15, 2022 meeting, the Audit Committee reviewed the draft RFP and adopted a resolution recommending that the RFP for the Defined Benefit Plan Investment Consultant be approved and issued by the Retirement Commission, and

WHEREAS, at its December 19, 2022 meeting, the Retirement Commission approved the RFP and issued the Defined Benefit Plan Investment Consultant RFP on Wednesday, January 4, 2023, with responses due to the Retirement System by Tuesday, February 21, 2023 at 3:00 p.m. local time (EST); and

WHEREAS, the Retirement Commission referred consideration of the RFP responses to the Audit Committee to, in consultation with the Executive Director in accordance with Section 10(d) of the Rules of Procedure, review the responses and submit a recommendation to the Retirement Commission, and

WHEREAS, the Audit Committee designated Commissioners, staff, and legal counsel to review the responses to the RFP and draft a summary of the responses, and

WHEREAS, at its June 14, 2023 meeting, after reviewing the RFP responses and the summary prepared by staff and legal counsel, the Audit Committee resolved to invite four (4) respondents to make presentations to the Audit Committee and answer questions concerning their responses to the RFP, and

WHEREAS, at its July 20, 2023 meeting, the Audit Committee met with the respondents and discussed the services each firm can offer and how each could effectively provide investment consulting services to the Retirement Commission, and



WHEREAS, the Audit Committee thoroughly reviewed and discussed the investment consultant services provided by the respondents and their responses to the RFP, and

WHEREAS, the Audit Committee unanimously resolved to submit a recommendation to the Retirement Commission to retain Kevin VandenHaute of Titan Wealth Advisors with Secure Asset Management ("Titan") as the Retirement System's Defined Benefit Plan Investment Consultant, and

WHEREAS, the Retirement Commission is of the considered opinion that it is in the best interest of the Members, Beneficiaries, and Participants for the Retirement Commission to retain the services of Titan as the Retirement System's Defined Benefit Plan Investment Consultant, and

WHEREAS, Titan has represented that it is empowered and authorized to provide the services contained in its RFP response and contract, and

WHEREAS, AndCo Consulting has agreed to assist Titan with the transition and recordkeeping through August 2023, therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Wayne County Employees' Retirement Commission, that in accordance with the provisions of the Plan and in consideration of its response to the RFP and the due diligence of the Audit Committee, the Retirement Commission hereby <u>Appoints</u> Kevin VandenHaute of Titan Wealth Advisors with Secure Asset Management to serve as the Investment Consultant for the Defined Benefit Plan effective August 1, 2023, and be it further
