9. Consideration of a Private Debt Search on the Defined Benefit Plan from AndCo Consulting. (Pass for the day May 31, 2023)

Mr. Simone moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Wayne County Employees' Retirement Commission (the "Retirement Commission") is vested with the authority for the general administration, management and operation of the Wayne County Employees' Retirement System (the "Retirement System") and has the fiduciary responsibility to invest Retirement System assets, and

WHEREAS, the Retirement Commission, in consultation with its Investment Consultant, has recently reviewed the Retirement System's investment portfolio and asset allocation in light of: (1) the portfolio's historical performance; (2) recent changes in the economic and financial market conditions; and (3) the Retirement Commission's goal of maximizing future gains without overly increasing risk or volatility in the portfolio, and

WHEREAS, in light of the foregoing and upon consultation with its Investment Consultant, AndCo Consulting, the Retirement Commission desires to make changes to its investment managers and the overall structure of its current investment portfolio, and

WHEREAS, the Retirement Commission's Investment Consultant, consistent with its role as an investment fiduciary to the Retirement System, has reviewed the Retirement System's portfolio and provided a written recommendation that the Retirement Commission commit \$12,000,000.00 to a Private Debt – Senior Direct Lending investment strategy, and

WHEREAS, the Retirement Commission has reviewed and discussed the prospective investment opportunity in PennantPark Credit Opportunities Fund IV with its Investment Consultant, and

WHEREAS, after the receipt of a written recommendation from its Investment Consultant and the completion of its due diligence, the Retirement Commission desires to retain



PennantPark Investment Advisers, LLC, as an Investment Manager and invest Retirement System assets in PennantPark Credit Opportunities Fund IV; therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Wayne County Employees' Retirement Commission, to <u>Appoint</u> PennantPark Investment Advisor, LLC (PennantPark) as an Investment Manager for the Retirement System to manage a Senior Direct Lending Portfolio via the Retirement System's investment of \$12,000,000.00 in PennantPark Credit Opportunities Fund IV; and further

RESOLVED, that contractual documentation for the investment is subject to approval as to form and content by the Retirement Commission's designated legal counsel, VanOverbeke, Michaud & Timmony, P.C., and will include a most favored nations provision with respect to applicable terms, and further

RESOLVED, that the Retirement Commission's Investment Consultant is hereby directed to coordinate the reallocation of the Retirement System's assets and to ensure that the reallocation is consistent with the Retirement Commission's directions and investment guidelines, and further

RESOLVED, that to the extent necessary, the Retirement Commission hereby directs its Custodial Bank to open an account for its assets to be managed by PennantPark, and further

RESOLVED, that a copy of the Resolution be forwarded to the Retirement System's Custodial Bank, PennantPark, and the Retirement Commission's Investment Consultant.

The motion was supported by Ms. McDonald and carried 6-1-1, with Mr. Tom Yee voting no and Mr. Ron Yee abstaining stating that he needed more information due to his status as a new Retirement Commissioner and there being no formal presentations by the four perspective managers.
