7. Consideration of a legal opinion from VanOverbeke, Michaud & Timmony, P.C. on PennantPark Credit Opportunities Fund IV documents and compliance with Michigan Public Act 314.

Mr. Simone moved the adoption of the following resolution:

RESOLVED, by the Wayne County Employees' Retirement Commission to <u>Accept</u> the legal opinion from VanOverbeke, Michaud & Timmony, P.C. on PennantPark Credit Opportunities Fund IV documents and compliance with Michigan Public Acts 314.

The motion was supported by Ms. Misuraca and carried unanimously 7-0.

9. Consideration of a confidential legal report from VanOverbeke, Michaud & Timmony, P.C.

The Retirement Commission returned to open session at 11:45 am with the following Commissioners present: Henry Wilson, Frank Simone, Elizabeth Misuraca, Ron Yee, Cassandra McDonald, Alisha Bell.

Ms. Simone moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Retirement Commission of the Wayne County Employees' Retirement System (the "Retirement Commission") is vested with the fiduciary responsibility for the proper administration, management and operation of the Retirement System, and for making effective the Retirement System provisions, and

WHEREAS, the Retirement Commission notes that notwithstanding that Article IV, Chapter 3, Section 4.312 of the Wayne County Home Rule Charter and Section 141-35(f)(2) of the Retirement System Ordinance which provide that County Corporation Counsel shall serve as legal advisor to the Retirement Commission, the provisions of Section 141-35(f)(5) of the Retirement Ordinance and Section 13(5) of Public Act 314 of 1965, as amended [MCL 38.113(5)], authorize the Retirement Commission to retain legal services as deemed necessary: (a) to protect the assets of the System; (b) to conduct the affairs of the System; and, (c) as required for the Commission to effectively carry-out its duties, and

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2020, retiree Dwayne Seals filed a Complaint against Wayne County, the Retirement System and Executive Director Robert Grden in U.S. District Court, Case No. 3:20-cv-11272, in which he requested declaratory and injunctive relief against the Retirement Commission, and

WHEREAS, the Retirement System was served with a summons and copy of the Amended Complaint, and

WHEREAS, by order dated August 4, 2022, Executive Director Grden was dismissed from the litigation, and

WHEREAS, the Retirement Commission previously retained the law firm of VanOverbeke, Michaud & Timmony, P.C. to serve as special legal counsel and to defend the Retirement Commission in this civil litigation, and



WHEREAS, that Retirement Commission reaffirms its prior resolutions engaging the services of VMT and formally authorizes VMT to represent the Retirement Commission in the *Dwayne Seals v Wayne County, et al.*, U.S. District Court, Case No. 3:20-cv-11272 litigation, and

WHEREAS, the case has been scheduled for a jury trial before Judge Sean F. Cox and the Retirement Commission desires to retain additional counsel to represent it in the litigation, and

WHEREAS, the Retirement Commission has previously retained The Miller Law Firm to serve as legal counsel and to represent the Retirement Commission in civil litigation, and therefore be it

RESOLVED, that Retirement Commission formally authorizes The Miller Law Firm to represent it in the *Dwayne Seals v Wayne County, et al.*, U.S. District Court, Case No. 3:20-cv-11272 litigation, and

RESOLVED, that VMT and The Miller Law Firm are authorized and shall continue to serve in that capacity until such time as the Retirement Commission withdraws that authorization at a public meeting.

The motion was supported by Ms. McDonald and carried unanimously 6-0.
